


Through the catalog page, and by registering in one of the 3 libraries, you have a personal account that let you:

le*catalogue farnése



Online since 2021, the Farnèse catalog collects the bibliographic records of the libraries of three institutions: the *École française de Rome*, the *Académie de France à Rome (Villa Médicis)* and the *Centre Jean Bérard* in Naples.

The catalog simple layout mirrors its accessibility, and allows you to start the search for physical and/or digital resources. It is also possible to restrict the search to one library, selected among those of the three institutions.

In line with Open Science, the catalog offers an increasing number of links to open access resources.

The Farnèse catalog is available in three languages: French, Italian, English.

SIMPLE SEARCH

The search bar offers 6 perimeters:


- « EVERYTHING » : searches among the records in the catalogue, the records coming from external resources (HAL) and the records made available by the publishers on the topics of the catalog
- « FARNESE CATALOG » : restricts the search to all the records in the catalog (therefore within the perimeter of the three libraries), including the electronic resources available.
- « ECOLE FRANCAISE DE ROME », « CENTRE JEAN BERARD », « VILLA MEDICIS » : further restricts the search to the physical collection of the selected library.
- « ON LINE » : searches exclusively among electronic resources.

The filters, available in the column on the right of the results window, allow you to refine your search, limiting the results by library, type of resource, language, date, etc. It is possible to use multiple filters in the same search.

ADVANCED SEARCH

With the « Advanced search » function you can search setting the same perimeters which are available in the simple search, but also creating and saving your own filters and your own search equations by working on: indexing, formulas, Boolean operators, document types, language and date of publication.

Create a search equation by adding search conditions, using the « add a new line » function.



SEE THE RESULTS

The search results are arranged in order of insertion in the catalogue. By selecting a title, the summary record of the document and its location are displayed; scroll down to see the detailed record.

LINKS ABOVE THE SEARCH BAR

They allow access to functions, services or collections of bibliographic records that change periodically according to the library events or the latest acquisitions. Those links evolve and are modified according to user needs.

ACCESS ARTICLES, JOURNALS AND DATABASES

The electronic resources proposed by the three libraries may appear among the results of a search, if they are available and if filters and search equations include them.

Library subscription and authentication are required to access some resources.

The staff constantly reports the free resources gradually made available on all the topics in the catalogue.
